Since then, she has served in a number of roles at Commonwealth Bank, including in the area of operations strategy.

In what is a newly-created role, Rose joins the growing consultancy as it celebrates its second anniversary. The firm was [founded by Cathro in 2021](#) during the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic after more than two and a half decades in business, including as an insolvency partner at Worreles, [Ernst & Young](#) and [Deloitte](#) and as a director at [PwC](#) joined by Andrew [Blundell shortly after](#).

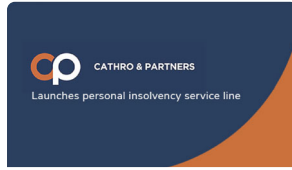
